Deploying and operating networks, particularly in deep rural areas, continues to be a significant challenge in the DRC. To bridge the digital divide and expand network coverage in underserved communities, the companies have pledged to jointly construct up to 2,000 new solar-powered base stations over six years, using 2G and 4G technologies.

Is the Democratic Republic of the Congo lagging behind in telecommunications?

Compared to the United States, the Democratic Republic of the Congo is massively lagging behind in the development of telecommunications. Under the country code +243, there were a total of 49.86 million connections in 2023. Among them were 49.80 million mobile phones, which corresponds to an average of 0.49 per person.

What is the telecommunications industry like in the DRC?

The telecommunications industry has not yet reached all potential consumers and has room to grow. Mobile telephones have a 44 percent penetration rate; internet penetration is approximately 3 percent of the total population. The DRC has not yet reached 5G and is still developing its 3G/4G network.

What is mobile internet penetration in the DRC?

Mobile Internet penetration in the DRC is at 32.3% and Orange and Vodacom's announcement to construct new base stations in the country aligns with the country's new vision for the digital economy as included in the National Digital Plan Horizon 2025 adopted in 2019.

How fast is the Internet in the Democratic Republic of the Congo?

The Democratic Republic of the Congo is lagging behind in the expansion of broadband internet connections. Around 31 percent of all residents have access to the internet. Around 0 percent have their own fast internet connection, which is at least faster than the former ISDN (more than 256 kbit/s).
